## My Reflection

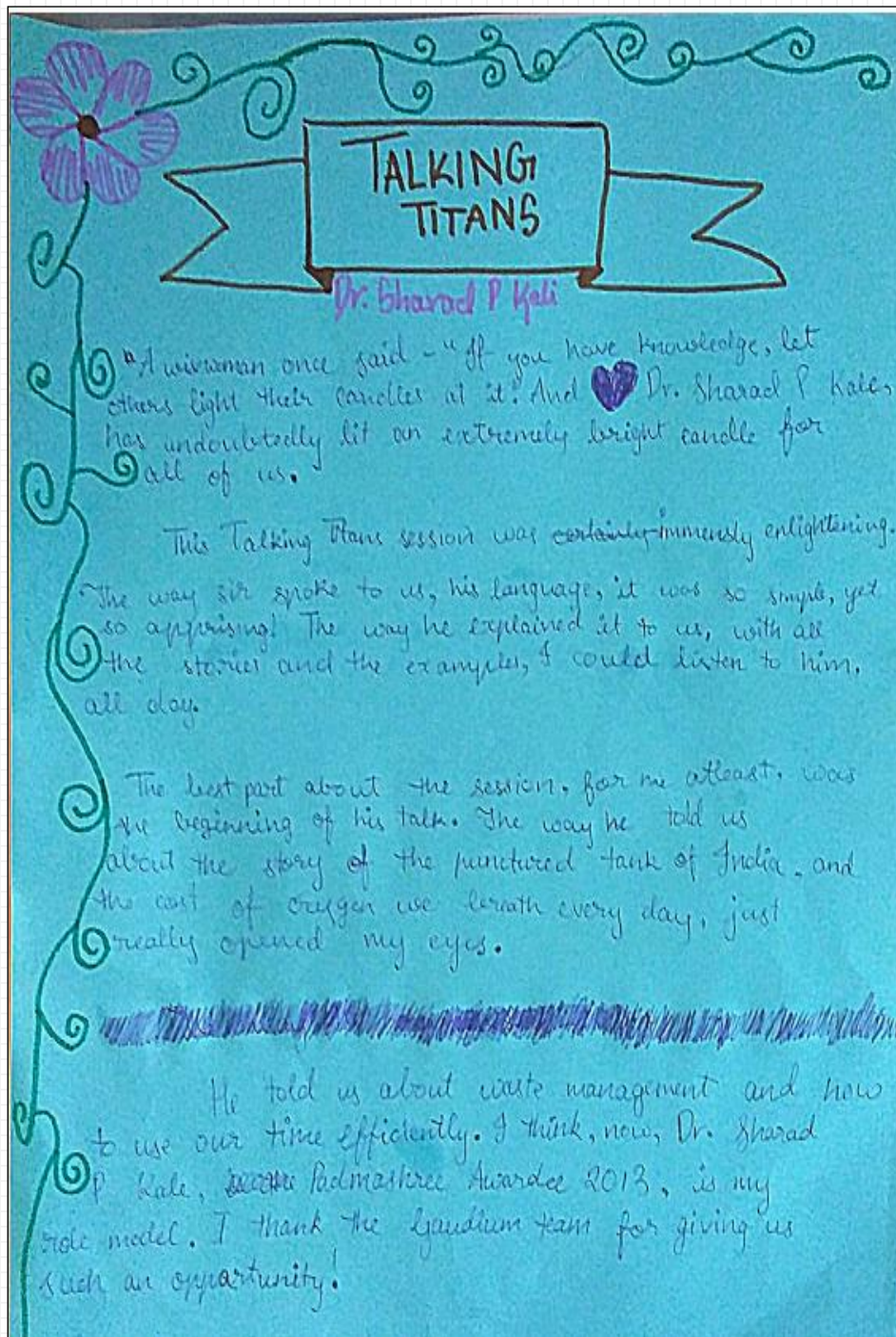

## गणतंत्र दिवस

सबसे पहले मैं आपको यह बताना चाहती हूँ कि गणतंत्र दिवस क्यों मनाया जाता है। दरअसल इस दिन ही हमारे देश को अपना संविधान मिला था। 26 जनवरी 1950 को सुबह 10 बजकर 18 मिनट पर भारत का संविधान लागू किया गया था। संविधान लागू होने के बाद हमारा देश भारत एक गणतंत्र देश बन गया। इस के 6 मिनट बाद 10 बजकर 24 मिनट पर राजेंद्र प्रसाद ने भारत के पहले राष्ट्रपति के रूप में शपथ ली थी। इस दिन पहली बार बतौर राष्ट्रपति डॉ राजेंद्र प्रसाद बगी पर बैठकर राष्ट्रपति भवन से निकले थे।

यह संविधान ही है जो भारत के सभी जाति और वर्ग के लोगों को एक दूसरे जोड़े रखता है। भारत का संविधान दुनिया का सबसे बड़ा लिखित संविधान है। 2 साल, 11 महीने और 18 दिन में यह तैयार हुआ था।

संविधान को लागू करने के लिए 26 जनवरी का दिन इसलिए चुना गया, क्योंकि 1930 में इसी दिन कांग्रेस के अधिवेशन में भारत को पूर्ण स्वराज की घोषणा की गई थी। गणतंत्र दिवस के अवसर पर राजपथ पर भव्य गणतंत्र दिवस समारोह का आयोजन होता है। राष्ट्रपति तिरंगा झंडा फहराते हैं। राष्ट्रगान और ध्वजारोहण के साथ उन्हें 21 तोपों की सलामी दी जाती है। अशोक चक्र और कीर्ति चक्र जैसे महत्वपूर्ण सम्मान दिए जाते हैं। राजपथ पर निकलने वाली झांकियों में भारत की विविधता में एकता की झलक दिखती है। परेड में भारत की तीनों सेना- नौ सेना, थल सेना और वायु सेना की टुकड़ी शामिल होती हैं और सेना की ताकत दिखती है।

आज हमारे विद्यालय गौडियम (THE GAUDIUM SCHOOL) में भी इसी तरह पूरे उत्साह तथा उल्लास के साथ *गणतंत्र दिवस* ऑनलाइन माध्यम द्वारा (Virtual Platform) मनाया गया। हमारे मुख्य अतिथि जी ने तथा प्रधानाचार्य जी ने अपने अमूल्य शब्दों से हमारे सभी विद्यार्थियों शिक्षक गण तथा अन्य अतिथियों का उत्साहवर्धन किया। विद्यार्थियों ने अपना हुनर दिखाते हुए, नृत्य प्रस्तुति, गान प्रस्तुति आदि कार्यक्रम प्रस्तुत किए गए। बहुत ही भव्य तरीके से कार्यक्रम की प्रस्तुति का समापन हुआ। सभी प्रस्तुति इतनी प्रेरणादायक तथा उत्साहवर्द्धक रही कि हम सभी को यह एहसास हुआ कि हम सभी को एक होकर भारत की समस्याओं को खत्म करने की कोशिश करनी चाहिए। भारत को जब तक इस समस्याओं से बाहर नहीं निकालते तब तक स्वतंत्रता सेनानियों का सपना पूरा नहीं होगा। एक होकर प्रयास करने से श्रेष्ठ और विकसित भारत का निर्माण होगा।

### Career Webinar by Japan University Consortium (JUC)

A career webinar was organized virtually on 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2020 by a group of five Japanese universities for the students of The Gaudium School. The session included the details from the reputed Universities of Japan, viz- Temple University, Nagoya University, NUCB University, Ritsumeikan Asia Pacific University, Ritsumeikan University. The session provided the geckos with very significant points and details on studying in Japan. From admission requirements to popular programs, fee and scholarship related details, everything was highlighted very well. The dilemma of students when it comes to studying in Japan/abroad were clarified well as they busted myths and highlighted several present offerings. The fact that these universities offer degrees in English, and many of them even have dual degree programs, where one can pursue studies for 2 years in Japan and then transfer to an associated university in another country also came to be known. The webinar was concluded with an open house round and vote of thanks.

Career counselling benefits the students in understanding the career options that they have and how to pursue them. It assists them to understand their own strengths and weaknesses with regard to their present course or profession and lets them know what career they would be best suited for. It not only gives them a platform to voice their opinion about what they would like to pursue, but also gives an opportunity to discuss the obstacles that they may be worried about.

At The Gaudium, we believe these career sessions to be very beneficial. The school career counsellor Ms. Mahitha Sammeta organized a career counselling session on 27<sup>th</sup> January 2021 with Grade IX students to help them understand the importance of Academics and how to build their profile.
