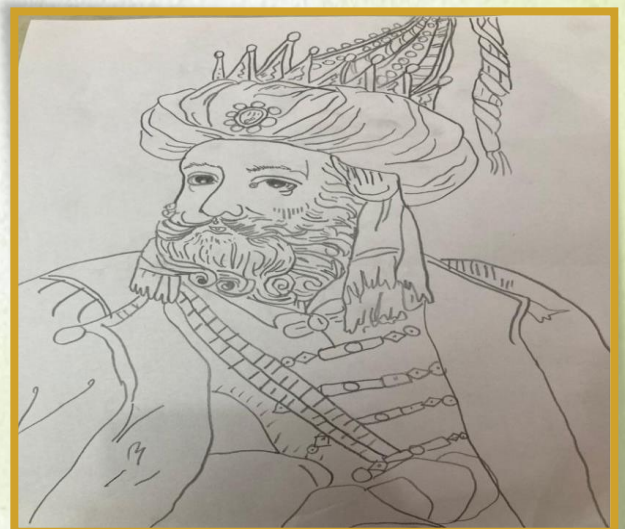
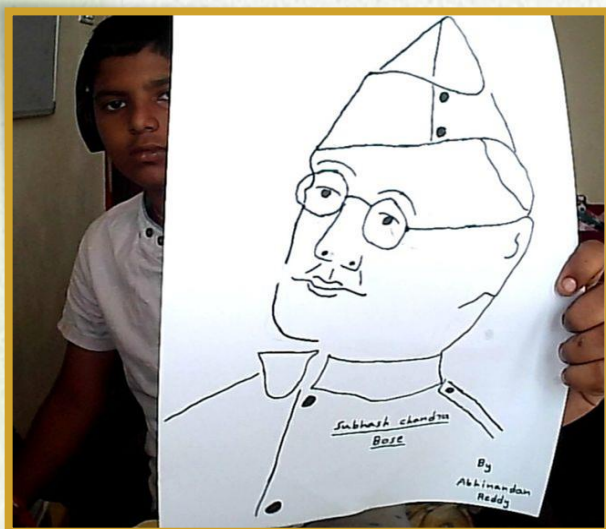
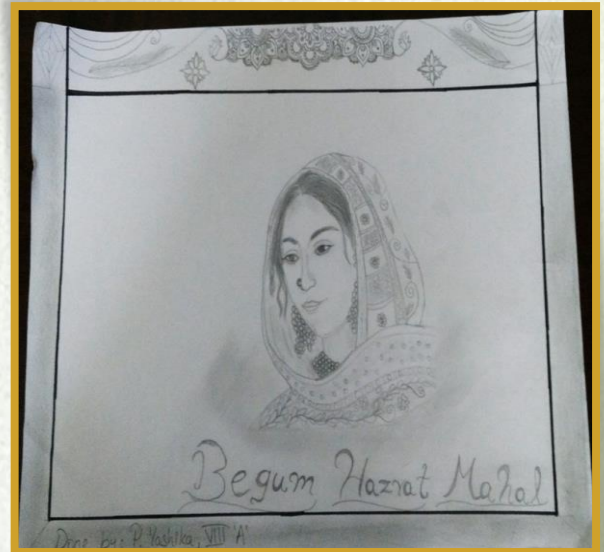
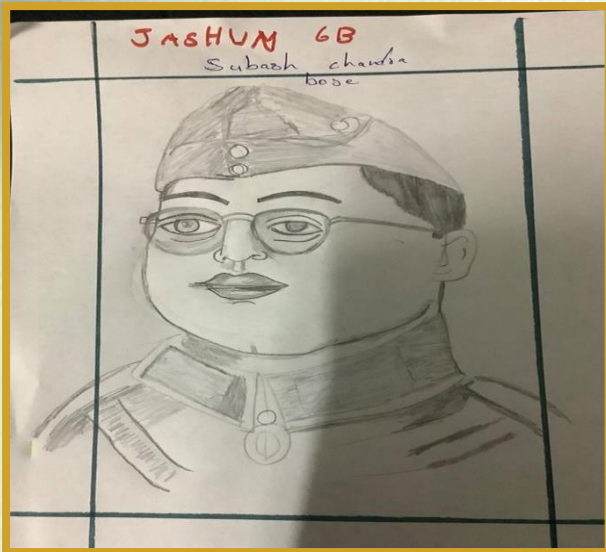
CORE VALUES

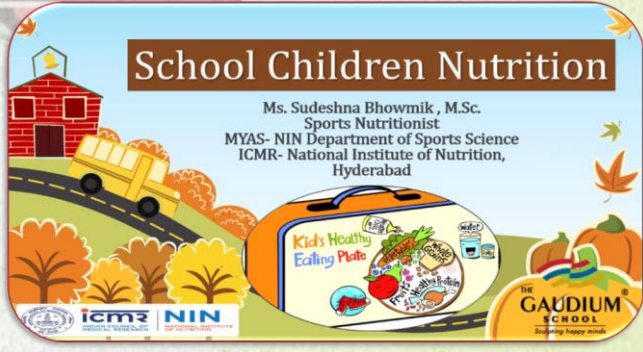

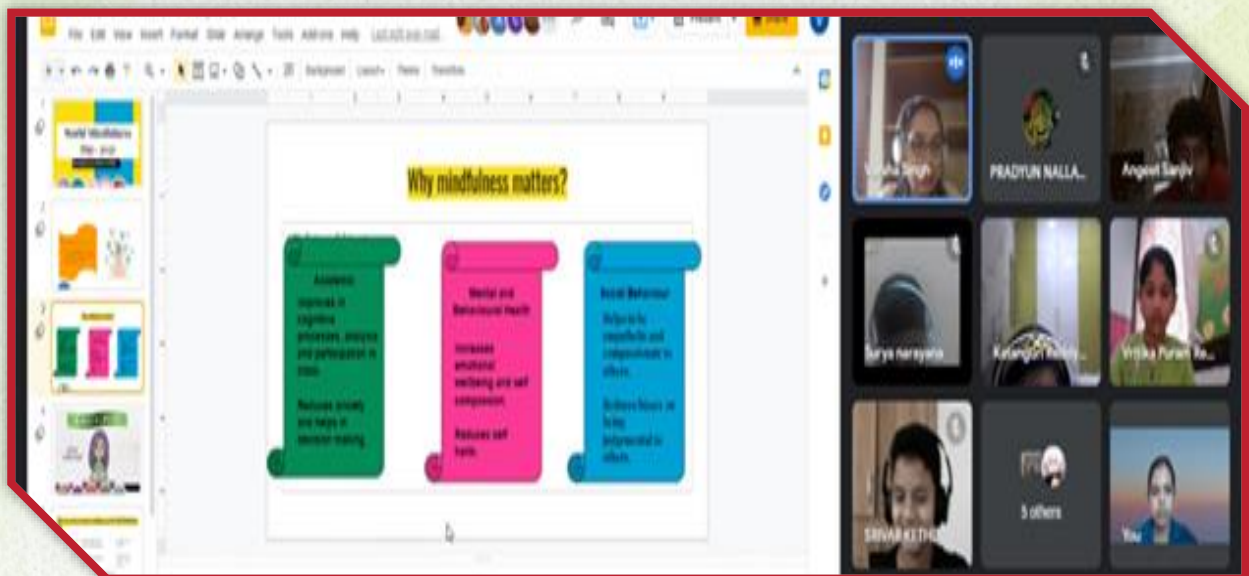

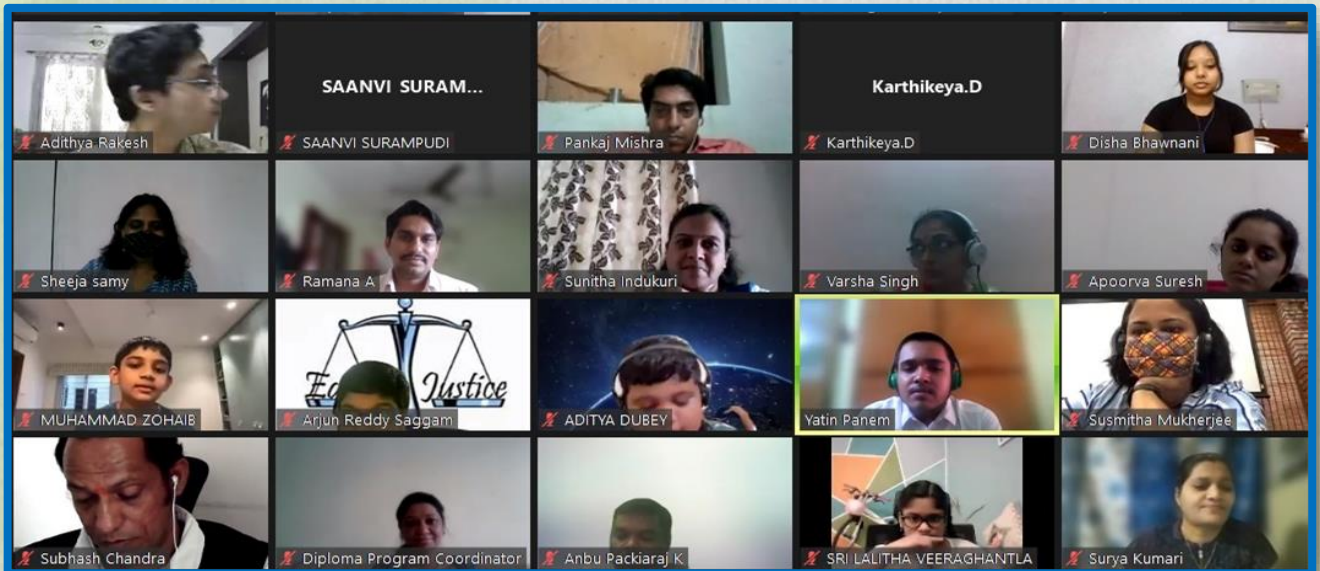
Teachers’ Day- A salute to the community whose influence extends beyond the classroom, well into the future.

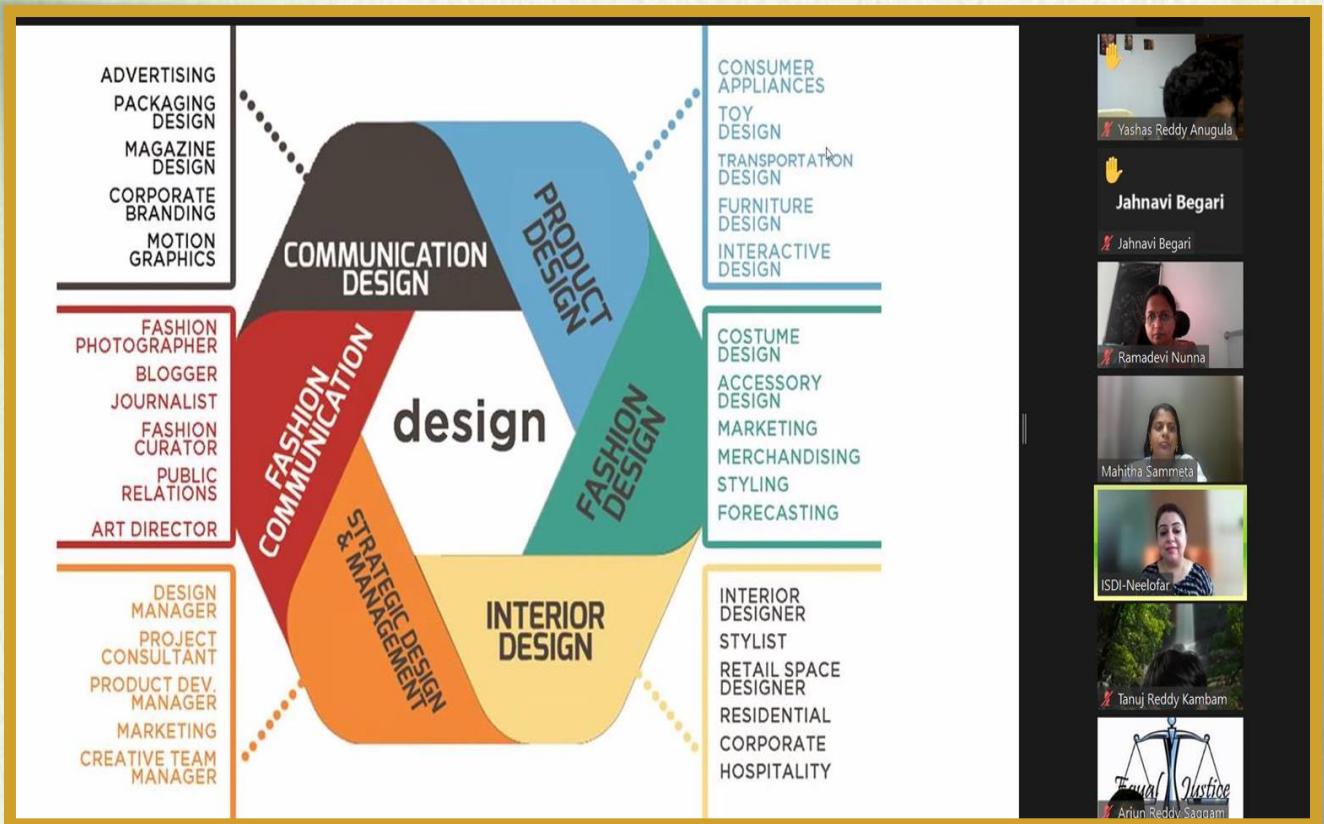

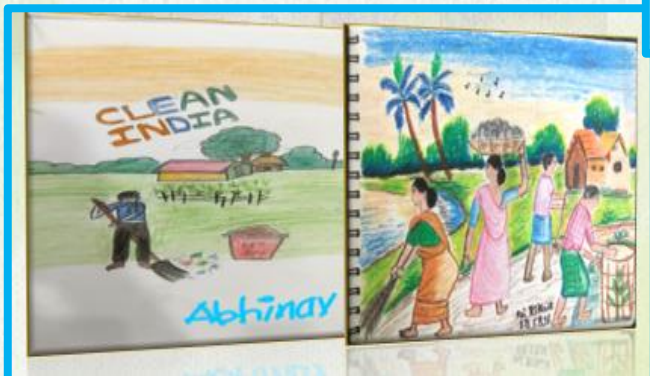
