Teacher's Corner

Learning is a continuous process which enables the learner to apply the academic content in real-life situations. The learner should analyse the given situation in a critical way to explore and identify multiple solutions which can be productive and lead to social efficacy.

Business Management in the Diploma Programme enables the learner to explore various situations in the external environment from a local to a global level. The learner gets an opportunity to observe the performance of various existing business organisations and make an attempt to observe and apply the strategies adopted by it under different scenarios. The syllabus of Business Management is designed in such a way that the learner will be able to acquire knowledge from the time of establishment to expand the business to national and international levels. Model case studies of the existing organisations are provided for the learner to simulate the application of the tools and theories. The student is encouraged to apply the tools and analyse the situation for an effective solution.

The syllabus is framed on the diagram where the students have an opportunity to visit the content and apply the concepts according to the context. Content provides the knowledge of different business organisations and the methods of recruitment to operate the enterprise efficiently. When the business is introducing the products and services, the methods of marketing and integration of technology are realised in the academic journey.

Concepts like Change, Culture, Ethics, Globalisation, Innovation and Strategy enable the student to anchor the tools and theories of the content to the provided case studies. The application skills are observed and assessed with the provided pre-seen case study in the external assessment.



Contexts can never be constant and the same solution may not be feasible for all the situations and enterprises. Along with the simulation case studies, the students are encouraged to select an organisation and explore on its strategies regarding its success or failure. The student explores by primary as well as secondary research which enhance their research and communication skills. The task is expected to complete in specific duration of 30 hours which emphasize on the time management skills of the student as a part of internal assessment.

By the time the course is completed, the student is familiarised with qualitative and quantitative tools which enable them to take decisions in the light of scientific tools rather than with intuition. Along with analysis, critical evaluation also becomes a part of the learning process. Observing and visiting different multinational companies and their strategies, the student is tuned with international mindedness making a responsible global citizen. The learner is trained to realise and synergize the skills and contribute to the society. The learner is supported by the educator at each and every stage so that no child is left behind in the academic journey. The learner is completed.



The process of creation, selection and rejection: To choose or not to choose

Choosing a medium that is appropriate to a concept is the most difficult task and key to the success of students' artwork. The material they use, the surface they work with, the marks they make, the colours they choose, the scale of the work – all of these contribute to the overall effect and how the work communicates. As students begin to resolve a range of developing pieces of art it encourages them to engage with the breadth of curatorial strategies that underpin exhibitions and the presentation of work for an audience. It involves them thinking about the process of selecting and rejecting works for exhibition, and considering how they can best be displayed. They investigate where and why finished pieces are selected for public display, explore the role of the curator and curatorial practices, and begin to understand and appreciate the decision-making process involved in communicating with audiences and presenting work.

The TOK Coordinator, Mr. Prithvi Sinha guided them and made them focus on the essay, urging them to engage with systems of thought in a way that is both rewarding and stimulating, thus delivering the impetus to pursue a trajectory of lifelong learning. This exercise makes them develop the tools and confidence needed to draw on many strands of a topic and produce a cohesive and meaningful argument that resists personal bias.

The date for final submission of EE was on 15th March and our students completed the submission much earlier than the deadline. The students did research in their favorite subjects and under the guidance of their supervisors they could showcase their knowledge and reading skills beyond the classroom syllabus.



These skills will enable students to acquire some of the skills that are essential for researching and writing their future research papers. As the DPC, it gives me immense satisfaction that the students have given their best and we could complete all the submissions on time. My heartfelt thanks also goes to the parents who supported the students and us as a school in this journey of learning.

The last date for submission of the Internal Assessments is 4th April 2022. Students have to attend the revision classes arranged for DP2 from 1st to 24th April to revisit the topics and prepare the students thoroughly for the upcoming board examinations.






Stakeholder Engagement-Mock Examination

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








Stakeholder Engagement- Chemistry Cat 3 Workshop
