The Middle Years Programme was introduced at the Gaudium School 2 years ago at the launch of an IB Forum [SAIBSA] hosted by our school. The idea of a continuum school brought new opportunities not only in terms of knowledge but in terms of aspiration of a school of thought that knitted perfectly with the philosophy of our establishment.

Learning to speak another language means taking one's place in the human community. It means reaching out to others across cultural and linguistic boundaries. Language is far more than a system to be explained. It is our most important link to the world around us. Language is culture in motion. It is people interacting with people. [Savignon 1983]

The study of additional languages in the MYP provides students with the opportunity to develop insights into the features, processes and craft of language and the concept of culture, and to realize that there are diverse ways of living, behaving and viewing the world.



Our school leaves no stone unturned to provide our young learners with such opportunities. At present, languages offered as Language acquisition comprises French, Spanish and Hindi. Learning of these languages at school reside upon the exploration of our cultural perspectives of our own and other communities.

Language acquisition is normally divided into 3 phases, Emergent, Capable and Proficient level. As we took our baby step to the introduction of MYP 1 & 2, all three languages have been taught at the Emergent level. While our first batch of board students enters MYP4 the next academic year, we are gearing up to a thorough preparation by trained teachers to help the students secure the best results in all the 4 skills Listening, Reading, Speaking and Writing.







Holistic Excellence Sciences - IB Learner Profile






Stakeholder Engagement International Women's Day Celebration
