

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Quiz Time in Grade 7 Mathematics Class

Mathematics in our classrooms is not just about numbers, equations, computations or algorithms chalked out in black and white; it is about beginning minutely and ending it magnificently. To enliven the spirit of the Mathematics class Grade 7 indulged in a numerical extravaganza while competing with their peers in a quiz on 'Rounding off to Significant Figures'



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Developing Critical Thinking Skills in Learners in the Computer Science Class.

Critical thinking has both implicit and explicit connections with Computer Science. One of the methodologies followed in the Cambridge Grade 8 Computer Science classroom teaching was using knowledge representation and reasoning. As you can see in the pictures students are presenting to their peers about their understanding of logic. In this process students are provided with logic; they have to analyze each and every statement given in the program. They then play the role of a compiler to identify how syntax works to connect theoretical concepts. Parse through the logic to understand the output produced by every line in the code. Delivering a detailed explanation build the confidence in them to not only solve technical issues, but also the resolve to face unfamiliar or menacing circumstances in life. By the end of the session students reflected on their learning and expressed how this activity had prepared them to be future-ready.

Line follower robot is one kind of autonomous robot which follows a line until that line exists. Generally, the line is drawn on the floor. It can be either black or white. The line can also be a normal visible color or an invisible magnetic field or electric field. The robot follows the line by using Infra-Red Ray (IR) sensors. There are five IR sensors which makes it an IR sensor array. You can see the students building the model here.




Enhancing Investigation Skills

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



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


Bonding Session for Teachers






A Rhythmic Reception to Middle School
