

ur skills classes came alive with the excitement of learning to cook some simple, wholesome meals without the quintessential fire element.














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#### Virtual interaction with Class VI








#### Principal's session on Al

NI Understanding what artificial intelligence is not enough until you know how it comes into play. If we can replicate the structure and the function of the human brain, we might be able to get cognitive capabilities in machines; this is the field of neural networks. If these networks are more complex and more in-depth and we use those to learn complicated things, that is the field of deep learning. There are different types of deep learning and machines that are fundamentally different techniques to replicate what the human brain does. Our Principal, Ms Shalini Singh Hamilton, in a session, enumerated how the knowledge of Artificial Intelligence is integrated in our curriculum to make the students future ready.


