Nowadays, LED lights are generally utilized by individuals to spare nature and power. It helps to lessen carbon discharge in the environment and applications are widely increasing.

During the STEAM classes, The learners were introduced to various electronic components like Light Emitting Diodes (LED's), Resistors, Switch, Breadboard, Battery etc.,. 



The opening ceremony was graced by the presence of Dr Vishnu Vardhan Reddy, IFS whose keynote address was an apt beginner. The ceremony was also graced by our two great support and guiding lights, our respected director, Ms Kirti Reddy and our veneered CEO, Mr Ramakrishna Reddy. Along with them were the principals, Ms Anjalika Sharma and Ms Shalini Singh Hamilton. After the lighting of the lamp, director and principal's message, welcome dance and the keynote speech, the Secretary-General, IBDP Year 2 student Mahathi Penmetsa announced the conference open by hitting the gavel.

The committee sessions under the able guidance of the Executive Board were extremely meaningful. Apart from being the first ever MUN at the campus of Gaudium, an MUN for the first time, had a socialising event in the form of sports and 225 delegates from more than 25 schools across the city loved the idea of mixing diplomacy and sports. Everyone including the secretariat, the EB, the OC along with the delegates came together in our state of the art sports infrastructure to have a game of football or cricket or badminton or basketball.


