Mental Health Day assembly

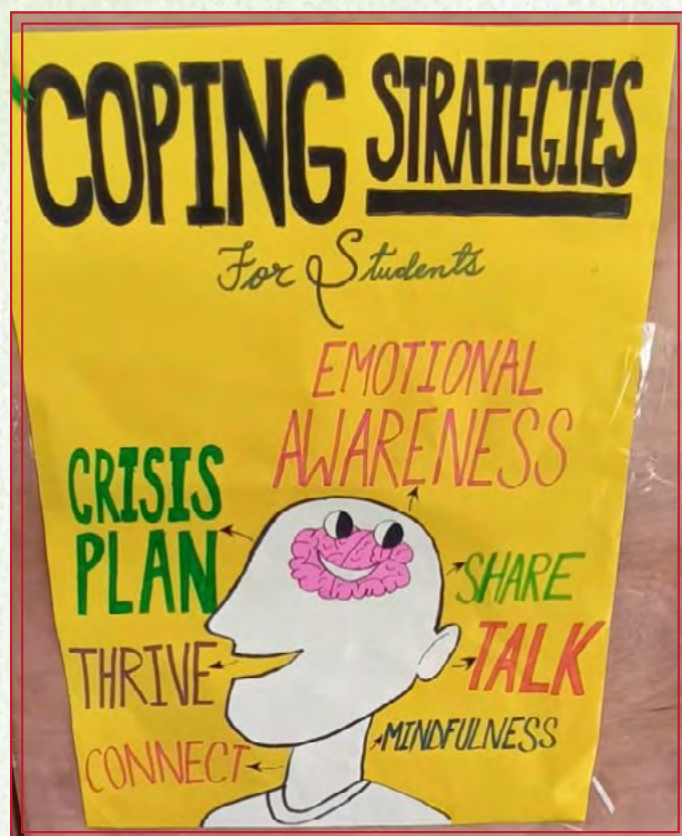
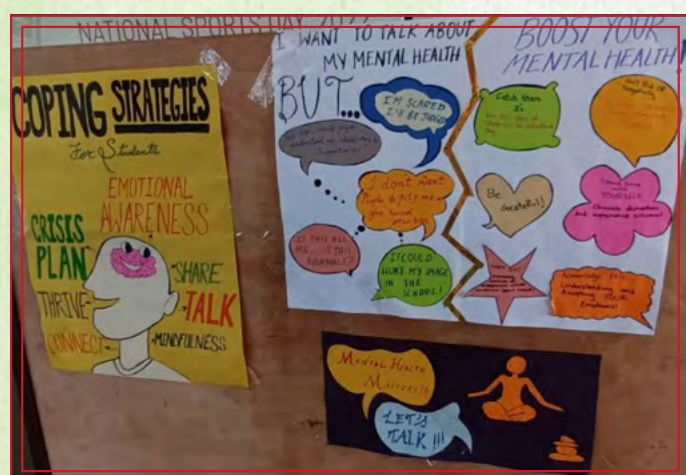
