Greetings of the day!






वाचन कौशल गतिविधि

Our skills classes came alive with the excitement of learning to cook some simple, wholesome meals without the quintessential fire element and also learning the basics of first aid.
















Pre-board Examinations for Grade 10

Art and Design Examinations in Progress










Class Assemblies based on the Core Value of 'Perseverance'






Cambridge Community Meet at DPS Nacharam
