Holistic Excellence- IBDP Science Group - 4 Presentation



The IB Programme is all about experiential learning. The Group 4 Project is one of the opportunities in the curriculum that encourages practice-based learning, interdisciplinary collaboration across different scientific disciplines, appreciation of the implications of science and exchanging or sharing of both data collected and issues raised. It also shows the limitations of scientific study which aids the students in exploring the area of knowledge of the Natural Sciences in Theory of Knowledge.

The project is designed to give the students a chance to explore any idea related to science that they are curious about. While the ideas are always different, they are united under a general theme which this year was "Myths in sciences".

On the 10th of November 2022, DP Year 1 students presented their findings and suggestions on the topic. The objective of the G4 presentation is sharing students' reflection, both successes and failures, with other students and the school community. Presentation is an integral element of the Science group 4 project which emphasises the planning, action and reflection process. The presentation is formal and organised in the form of an exhibition where students display in the form of charts summarising the activities of each group. This created a space for exchange or expunge of scientific understanding as students and teachers from the whole of high school came together to witness the the students' presentation. Students discussed about their findings for specific subjects and reflected on their learning and findings as a group in front of the TGS family comprising teachers and students from all the other segments.

2. **अनुभव** (फुर्सत के पल, यात्रा, दैनिक जीवन से जुड़ी हुई कहानियाँ, धार्मिक आचार-विचार, रीति-रिवाज़, प्रवास-स्थानांतरण)
3. **मानवीय सरलता** (मनोरंजन, कलात्मक हावभाव, संचार माध्यम, तंत्रज्ञान, वैज्ञानिक नवोन्मेष)
4. **सामाजिक संरचना** (सामाजिक संबंध, समाज, सामाजिक जुड़ाव, शिक्षा, कार्यरत विश्व, कानून और सुव्यवस्था)




Stakeholders connect: Children's day Celebration




College Application: Process Orientation

Our school career counsellor Ms. Mahitha Sammeta organised a session for IBDP & CBSE students on "How to begin the College Application Process".

She also stressed on starting the preparation of standardised tests early. The significance of the Personal Essay and the basic country-wise application requirements were also delineated.

She is the winner of the prestigious Indian National Writing competition of the French Teachers "*Concours d'écriture - Covid-19. Et après?*". She was conferred this award in the presence of the Consul Generals of 7 countries and other dignitaries. Her article was much appreciated and applauded by all the dignitaries and the jury. It was published on the website of IFI and many of its partners and she was interviewed for '*le Petit Journal de Bombay*'.

The competition took place between 25th November 2021 and 30th March 2022. It was conducted by the French Embassy in India, the Institute of France in India (IFI) and its partners.

Her prize for this competition was the much sought after *Université d'Automne* which is held annually. The *Université d'Automne* has a rigorous selection procedure and only a few teachers get selected for it.

She was invited to attend the *Université d'Automne* in Jaipur, Rajasthan in the second week of November 2022. It was a week-long Workshop for French Teachers in India conducted by the Embassy of France and IFI. Here they get an opportunity to learn new techniques and methods from the esteemed and very experienced French teacher trainers who come from France for this workshop.
