We witnessed an enthralling presentation of skills of our students during the annual day which emphasized on values of relationship, co-operation and were depicted with meaningful life lessons. It was the result of continuous planning, training, and cooperation by all the members of school community focusing on the creativity and collaboration of students.

While presentation skill was the highlight, students were also busy inquiring about different lines of inquiry related to the unit. In connection with the current unit of inquiry, our Grade 1 students used Design Thinking to identify potential problems around them and find solutions demonstrating their imagination and creativity.

Students of Grade 2 inquired into challenges associated with a choice of material, during its manufacture or while processing and with the by-products.



They used the Design Thinking process to come up with innovative solutions and prototype to overcome the challenges identified.

The process of empathizing to understand the problem, defining the problem, ideating, creating the prototype, builds the necessary skills for students to look at a problem with a new perspective and become problem-finders and problem-solvers.







It's a collaborative process of learning which requires support from peers, teachers as well as parents. At home, you may discuss the problem your child has identified as a part of design thinking process and extend help as they research while gathering information to understand the problem better.



Unit of Inquiry:

For prior knowledge assessment students visited 4 stations of pictures related journey, stories related to journey and they were able to come up with the word journey .They shared meaning of the word journey. They referred the dictionary to know the exact meaning of the word journey. They differentiated journey and non journey .They shared different types of journeys like short journey ,long journey etc..









Transdisciplinary Language: In

connection with UOI, learners made a transdisciplinary connection past ,present and future while they were sharing about their experiences during their journey. Students revisited the concepts of adjectives ,antonyms and picture description

Transdisciplinary Math: Learners made a transdisciplinary connection with time ,days of the week and months. They shared the number of days in a week and the number of months in a year.

They revisited the concepts of 3D and 2D shapes , word problems and measurements

Drama: Students have chosen the next 3 emotions and shared how they show them through their expressions.

Each student has been given an emoticon and asked to enact his/her peers will be asked to guess/ identity it.

PE: Students had a discussion on different types of jumping like forward and backward and demonstrated the same.They explored standing broad jumps and they practiced the same.









Art: Students learnt different elements of art.They created an artwork using different elements of art and using various artform for Christmas celebration.

Music: Students revisited emotions and feelings through music. Students listened to the music and identified the emotions – happy,sad, scary,funny etc. Students practiced The Grandfather's clock, 500 miles and Carols with the teacher using electronic keyboard as a resource. **Dance:**Students have learned full body movements and gestures like shake, jumps, turns, hand and leg coordination, footwork, locomotors and non locomotors.

Hindi :Students were introduced to 'vyanjan' Akshar ण and 'त' Varg (त, থ) through- pictures, poems, and stories. They revised the letters from 'k' Varg,` ch' Varg, and `T' varg letters. Learners enthusiastically identified, pronounced, and wrote the Akshar ण and 'त' Varg (त,थ) from objects and pictures which were shown to them. Students were introduced to the 'द् `and`ध` letter through stories, flash cards. They were able to identify and write the letter 'द`and`ध`.







Telugu:

Students were introduced to the letters tha, thha, through storytelling and finding objects.

Reinforcement of letters Ta,cha and ta varg letters, numbers and poems was done.

French: Students were introduced to describe their family in French. They were also introduced to 'definite articles' in French and learnt a few fruits and vegetables names along with definite articles. They learnt how to say 'All about yourself' in French. They watched a short poem/rhyme related to my family, definite articles, fruit and vegetable names in French.

Spanish:

Students were introduced to describe their family in Spanish. They were introduced to definite articles in Spanish. They learnt names of a few fruits and vegetables along with definite articles. They learnt how to say 'All about yourself' in Spanish. They watched a short poem/rhyme related to my family, definite articles, fruit names and vegetable names in Spanish.

Learning and Teaching- Month Ahead

Dance: Students will be learning different elements of hip hop dance like top rock, down rock, body isolation, different patterns of hand and leg movements, uses of prop.

Art:

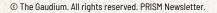
Students will explore different artform like printing, stamping and paper folding. They will be using colour paint to create the impression with an object of their choice in their artwork.

Music: Students will be introduced to Sare Jahan Se Achha and We shall Overcome and watch the songs. Students will practice the songs along with the teacher with the help of electronic keyboard. **Drama:** Students will watch a children's opera theatre show. Analyze and imitate sound from video. They will identify the sounds and connect to the emotions.

PE: Students will be engaged in the following practice sessions:

-Students will explore under arm throw they will practice the same.

Students will be have a discussion about overarm throw and will practice the same.
Students will discuss about football and basketball rules.
Students will explore some specific warm-up.
