MUN is an excellent platform for nurturing leadership skills, and we look forward to more such endeavours.






Speaking and listening test in English:

Steam and Robotics - Building Mini Golf mechanism

The Grade VI students have constructed a MINI GOLF robot using LEGO Mindstorms EV3 education kit. The learners have initially designed and presented their idea, identified the material from lab resources and constructed the mechanism to hit the ball when the switch is pressed.

The learners have explored and collected the various building blocks to construct the balanced and rigid mechanism. Interfaced one touch sensor to command the machine to hit the ball and programmed the EV3 brain to take the inputs from the sensor, process and control the motor with appropriate actions.

The learners have had fun making the mechanism using LEGO programmable kits and developed the mechanism with good team efforts.

As the Term 1 exams approached, our school buzzed with focused preparation and diligent revision sessions. Teachers and students collaboratively undertook strategies like mock tests, group studies, and study lounge sessions.


