## Holistic Excellence

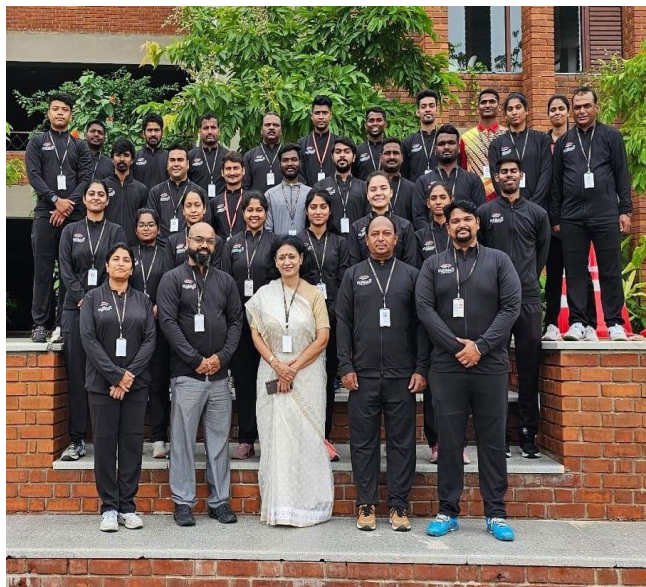
"Empowering future leaders through sports."

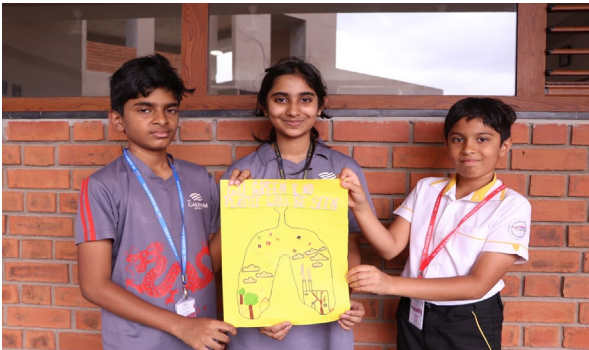
