Students of IX D have done the activity of observing onion peel cells under a microscope has several learning outcomes: understanding cell structure, learning to use a microscope, making scientific observations, and distinguishing between plant and animal cells. Students will document their observations and reports, reinforcing their understanding through "learning by doing." This hands-on approach not only enhances theoretical knowledge but also increases interest in Biology, making the subject more engaging and relatable for students.





Grade XII B students had a flipped class for English to enhance deeper understanding of the text and making students independent learners. In this process classroom becomes more dynamic and engaging in an interactive environment.







English Teacher organized a garden classroom and held "**Just a Minute**" sessions, where 9A students enthusiastically spoke on diverse topics. This was part of our "Happy English" program aimed at enhancing their communication skills in an engaging and enjoyable environment.



Newton's Laws Simulation-Based Activity

In this engaging and interactive activity, students explored the fundamental principles of Newton's Laws of Motion through a simulation-based experience. This hands-on activity helped students understand the effect of force on acceleration, how varying the mass of an object influences its acceleration under a constant force, and the relationship between mass and acceleration. They then applied this knowledge to explain and teach complex concepts, fostering a deeper understanding of the principles governing motion and forces in our world.





Exploring Art: A Summary of Grade 11 Painting Students' Academic Work

In Grade 11 painting classes, students engage deeply with the fundamentals of art to develop both technical skills and personal expression. This academic journey focuses on the seven essential elements of art: line, shape, form, space, value, color, and texture.





Grade X students have performed a hands-on activity to learn the concepts of refraction through a **glass slab experiment**. This activity helped them gain clarity on concepts such as lateral shift, angle of incidence, angle of emergence, and factors affecting the lateral shift.





To learn **Euclid's geometry** students of IX B have done a group activity of explaining the axioms and postulates to each other through activities. The students proved that the theorem which states that "Vertically opposite angles are equal" by doing the activity.





Celebrating Telangana's Rich Cultural Heritage: A Grade 11 Art Project

Our Grade 11 students have embarked on an inspiring artistic journey, delving into the vibrant and diverse cultural heritage of Telangana through a special painting project. This creative endeavor was designed not only to enhance their artistic skills but also to deepen their appreciation for the rich traditions and cultural legacy of the Telangana region.





IX B has done an activity, which involves creating models of plant and animal cells using biodegradable materials under the "Best out of Waste" concept. Students will gain a deeper understanding of cell structure and function through hands-on learning and scientific observation. This activity promoted teamwork, critical thinking, and creativity, allowing students to apply theoretical knowledge of cell biology in a practical way. By visualizing the differences between plant and animal cells, students reinforced their understanding and engaged in inquiry-based learning.















Class X CBSE students observed stomata using a microscope, understanding their structure and role in photosynthesis. They learned to use a microscope and made detailed observations and reports. This handson activity, based on "learning by doing," reinforced theoretical knowledge and increased their interest in biology.







Psychology students of class XII Students participated in a flipped learning session to understand sensory, attentional, and perceptual processes. The session covered how we perceive the world, sense modalities, attentional processing, perceptual mechanisms, principles of perception, depth and distance perception, perceptual constancies, illusions, and socio-cultural influences on perception. This approach allowed students to explore these topics independently, leading to deeper understanding and engagement in interactive classroom discussions and activities.















Grade 11 AI students recently participated in an exciting activity, contributing 350 words related to AI terminologies. Together, they created an impressive online word cloud. This engaging exercise not only deepened their understanding of AI but also provided a fun and interactive learning experience. Great job, students!

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


Trip to Biscuit factory


